Meeting called to order by Chair Aaron Lenmark.

**ROLL CALL:** Present - Judge Glonek, Ann Doucette, Nick Alexander, Mark Liebaert, Michele Wick, Leslie Dollen, Pat Schanen, Donna Stone, Aaron Lenmark, Mark Fruehauf (arrived 12:10 p.m.). Absent - Judge Thimm, Rebecca Lovejoy, Tom Dalbec, Robert Galovich, Frog Prell, Jen Stank, Carolyn Pierce, Carolyn Jones. Others present – Shelley Nelson (Telegram), Charlie Glazman, Ellen Acker (Public Defender), Pam Tafelski (Committee Clerk).

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** Motion by Alexander, second Dollen, to approve April 12, 2018, meeting minutes. Motion carried.

**WITC ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR DEPT. OF CORRECTIONS TRAINING PROGRAM:** Charlie Glazman, WITC, summarized success of welding boot camps training program. Department of Corrections (DOC) recognized potential for expanding this initiative. WITC received DOC grant to explore boot camp potentials; grant requires Advisory Committee to include volunteer from the CJCC. Lenmark volunteered. D.A.'s office will also be involved.

**HEROIN DIVERSION GRANT AWARD TO DOUGLAS COUNTY:** Douglas County is one of three Wisconsin counties to receive the \$160,000 grant. Development of Policy and Procedures Manual and organizational framework for the diversion program is in progress. Grant will fund about 20 persons/year. Program components reviewed.

**GOALS FOR 2018:**

**Priority #1 – “Warrant Resolution Day” Work Group Report:** Group met three times, including discussion with St. Louis County and Duluth Police Department. Coordination critical between court system offices, law enforcement, and agencies that can provide assistance (e.g. Health & Human Services, DNA testing and fingerprinting). St. Louis County emphasized BE PERSISTENT; do not get discouraged if not many show up to initial events. First event September/October with widespread media campaign.

**Priority #2 – 2018-2019 Community Service Work Program (CSWP) for Douglas County Work Group Report:** No report; group has not met due to scheduling conflicts.

**FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:** City considering ordinance to make misdemeanor THC possession not a criminal offense.

**ADJOURNMENT:** Motion by Fruehauf, second Schanen, to adjourn. Motion carried. Adjourned at 12:40 p.m. Next meeting October 11, 2018.
