Stat. §19.85(1)(g) to confer with legal counsel with respect to legal strategy and advice regarding specific Chapter 980 supervised release cases and/or pursuant to Wis. Stat. §19.85(1)(f) to consider financial, medical, social or personal histories of specific persons, which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or date, in particular, to discuss and apply confidential information and statutory factors to specific offender cases to develop potential placements for supervised release per Wis. Stat. §980.08(4)(dm). If the Committee convenes in closed session, it will reconvene in open session prior to taking any action.
- b. Reconvene into Open Session: The Committee shall reconvene into open session for possible voting and/or other action resulting from discussing and applying confidential information and statutory factors to specific supervised release cases to develop potential placements for supervised release pursuant to Wis. Stat. §980.04(4)(dm).
